**Event** : GSP VISAYAS 60<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CAMP 2024

**Date & Venue** : April 6-10, 2024  
MYVRPTC, Barangay Kalunasan, Cebu City

**Theme** : *Camp Marina: Six Decades of Empowerment and Excellence*

**Participants** : Junior – minimum of four (4) patrols (of 8 girls) with two Adult Leaders per patrol  
Senior – minimum of four (4) patrols (of 8 girls) per Council

**Camp Fee** : P4, 800.00 per camper (to cover food & accommodation, program materials, Souvenirs (T-shirt, Scarf, Bag), Tour and One (1) pc. 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Raffle Ticket per participant.

*First meal is breakfast on April 6 and last meal is lunch on April 10, 2024.*

**Pre-Campference** : April 5, 2024, 9:00 A.M. (start of meeting of all Central Staff)

*All Troop Leaders/Trainers who will serve as Central Staff are required to attend the Central Staff Pre-Campference/Meeting.*

**Arrival and Settling Down** : April 6, 2024 A.M.

**Opening Program** : April 6, 2024 4:00 P.M.

**Closing Ceremony** : April 10, 2024 9:00 A.M.

**Departure** : April 10, 2024 P.M.

**Qualifications of Participants:**

- Girls** - must be registered Junior, Senior & Cadet Girl Scouts as of June 30, 2024
  - must be physically fit and alert as certified by a licensed physician
  - must have earned at least one badge under the challenge of Environment, Preparedness, Arts, Heritage & Citizenship
- Adult** - must be registered Troop Leader as of June 30, 2024
  - must have undertaken the Outdoor Leadership Course or must be a Campcraft Certificate Holder
  - must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life
  - must know and understand her girls
  - must know simple First Aid

*A Physical re-check shall be conducted upon arrival in camp. Be sure that the Girls shall be bringing with them their individual Health Form and Parent's Consent Form during the physical re-check.*

The activities shall include:

- Junior - Handcraft, Adventure Games, Swimming, Arts & Crafts, Emergency Preparedness, Tour, Evening Socials, Council Extravaganza, Campfire, Scout's Own.
- Senior - Obstacle Games, Handicraft, Scavenger Hunt, Primitive Cooking, Rock Climbing, Tour, Evening Socials, Council Extravaganza, Campfire, Scout's Own.


