
The UP Visayas Ugnayan ng Pahinungód/Oblation Corps (UPV UP/OC) is the volunteer service program of the University of the Philippines under the Office of the Chancellor that serves the underserved communities in the country, especially in Western Visayas. The UPV UP/OC promotes different advocacies through its programs and projects wherein volunteers composed of UPV students, faculty, staff, and alumni serve as its core support system.

This year, the UPV UP/OC will conduct the UPV Aabutin Ang Pangarap (UPV-AAP) Caravan and invite representatives from all high schools in each province of Western Visayas. The carayan aims to widen the scope of information dissemination about the UP admission process and the scholarship opportunities to Grade 11 students, especially those in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA), through the Affirmative Action Program (AAP). To help the students prepare for the entrance examination, a 3-day College Admission Test and Refresher (CATSaR) program will be conducted, which they can also use for other higher education institutions. Complementary to these initiatives for students is the Teacher Development Program (TDP), which aims to improve the capabilities of teachers in delivering quality education. Please see the attached primer for more information.

To fully materialize the objectives of the program and ensure its success, we would like to request the following from the Division of Capiz with the endorsement of DepEd Region VI -Regional Office:

- 1. Serve as our official partner and assist in the implementation of the UPV-AAP carayan in Capiz on May 3-5, 2024. The venue is to be finalized with the SGOD.
- 2. Send a communication to all public and private high schools in the region to select and send two (2) Grade 11 students for the AAP and CATSaR and one (1) teacher to attend the TDP during the 2-day caravan.
- 3. Identify the ten (10) most deserving GIDA/Last Mile Schools that will be given five (5) student slots. Schools that would like to request additional slots may also directly contact the UPV UP/OC office (see contact details below) to check the availability of slots for the activity.
- 4. Update UPV UP/OC regarding the confirmed slots for students and teachers, preferably on or before April 26, 2024.
- 5. Coordinate with the UPV Ugnayan ng Pahinungód/Oblation Corps in the implementation of the Program;
- 6. Assist student representatives in conducting an echo seminar in their respective schools by coordinating with their respective guidance counselor's office.






MANDATE




This year, the three programs will be merged into a 3-day UPV-Aabutin ang Pangarap (UPV-AAP) Caravan in each province to maximize the resources of the volunteers and participants. Also, the UPV-AAP caravan will invite representatives (2 students and 1 teacher) from all schools in the province to attend the 3-day program (please refer to the succeeding slides). GIDA schools will be prioritized and given five (5) slots for students.

UPV-AAP Caravan 2024 (Current Implementation)



- Affirmative Action Program is designed to prepare Grade 11 students for the rigors of university life. This includes tutorial sessions for taking college entrance examinations, such as the UP-College Admission Test (UPCAT).
- CATSaR (College Admission Test Simulation and Refresher)
 is comprised of two key components, namely: (1) College Admission Test
 Simulation-students will undergo a mock exam to prepare them for future admission
 tests and (2) Refresher students will be provided an overview of the topics and subject
 matters that are generally covered during college entrance examinations.
- Teacher Development Program (TDP) is a program that seeks to strengthen
 teaching strategies among public high school teachers. It aims to improve the
 capabilities of teachers in delivering quality education through pedagogical enrichment.


