

Although science magic tricks may seem to defy the laws of nature at first glance, they are based on scientific principles and can be explained through careful observation, critical thinking, and an understanding of the underlying science. By blending the wonder of magic with scientific rigor, science magic serves as a powerful tool to inspire interest in the natural world and promote scientific literacy.
