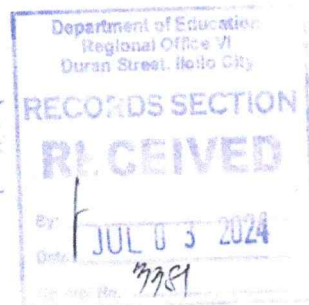

FSP-INDIGENOUS CULTURAL COMMUNITIES/ INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

Guidelines

- Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen
- Any ALS/HS/SHS graduates/graduating students
- Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, whether or not he has earned any units in college
- Those currently enrolled in Bachelor of Science in Fisheries but not FSP scholar and those who have earned units with BSF or non-BSF may also apply
- Bona fide member duly recognized and certified in his/her community duly recognized and certified by the NCIP
- For ALS/high school graduate applicants the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 75%
- For graduating students under K to 12 program, Grade 11 GWA shall not be lower than 75% or its equivalent
- Of good moral character as certified by the School Head/Principal and Community Resident Leader
- Parent(s)/guardian(s) must be a member of a particular tribe recognized by the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP)

Requirements

- Duly accomplished and signed FSP Application Form for the FSP-ICCs/IPs
- Original or Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate issued either by PSA (formerly NSO) or Civil Registrar
- Certified True Copy of Report Card Form 136 or 137 (GWA of Grade 11 shall not be lower than 75%)
- Certification of good moral character from the School Registrar and Community Resident Leader
- Certificate of Confirmation (COC) issued by NCIP-Regional/Provincial Office or Certification from Tribal Chieftain
- Two (2) recent 2x2 pictures taken within the last three (3) months prior to filing of application; colored with white background (photos taken thru mobile phones may be allowed)
- Barangay Residence Certificate of the parent(s)/guardian(s)
- In case of guardianship, affidavit executed by the guardian(s) attesting that the applicant is his/her ward for at least one (1) year

FISHERFOLK CHILDREN EDUCATIONAL GRANT

Guidelines

- Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen
- Any Senior high school graduate or graduating student whose parent(s) or guardian(s) is a Registered Fisherfolk (Fish-R/Mangangisdang Juan)
- Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, who has not earned any units in college
- For high school graduate applicants who completed their high school under the old curriculum, the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%
- For Senior High School students under K to 12 curriculum, graduating students GWA of the last 3 immediate preceding semesters of his Senior High School in any Track shall not be lower than 80% or its equivalent
- Of good moral character as certified by the School Head/Principal
- Parent(s)/guardian or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality of the Region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted;
- Parent(s)/guardian must be registered municipal fisherfolk duly certified by the Municipal Agricultural Officer (MAO) or the BFAR Regional Office in his/her area

Requirements

- Duly accomplished and signed FSP Application Form for the FCEG
- Original or Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate issued either by PSA (formerly NSO) or Civil Registrar
- Certified True Copy of Report Card Form I38 or 137 (GWA of last 3 semesters of Senior High School is at least 80%)
- Certification of good moral character from the School Registrar
- Photocopy of Fish-R/Mangangisdang Juan ID or Certificate of Registration of parent(s)/guardian (issued by the MAO or BFAR)
- Two (2) recent 2x2 pictures taken within the last three (3) months prior to filing of application; colored with white background (photos taken thru mobile phones may be allowed)
- Barangay Residence Certificate of the parent(s)/guardian(s)
- In case of guardianship, affidavit executed by the guardian attesting that the applicant is his/her ward for at least five (5) years

FISHERIES INDUSTRY LEADERS GRANT

Guidelines

- Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen
- Any high school graduate or graduating student
- Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, who has not earned any units in college
- Graduating student with HONORS, duly certified by the school head/ principal
- For high school graduate applicants who completed their high school under the old curriculum, the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%
- Of good moral character as certified by the school head
- Parent(s)/guardian or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality of the region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted

Requirements

- Duly accomplished and signed FSP Application Form for the FILG
- Original or Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate issued either by PSA (formerly NSO) or Civil Registrar
- Certified True Copy of Report Card Form I38 or 137 (GWA of last 3 semesters of Senior High School is at least 80%)
- Certification from the School Head that the applicant is an honor student or graduate with honors
- Certification of good moral character from the School Registrar
- Two (2) recent 2x2 pictures taken within the last three (3) months prior to filing of application; colored with white background (photos taken thru mobile phones may be allowed)
- Barangay Residence Certificate
