

1. The Capiz Council Boy Scouts of the Philippines will hold the:

- 2. The Scouts of the World Award Discovery (SWA) aims to:
 - Capacitate the young people with technical knowledge about the SWA Program;
 - b. Give young people the opportunity to explore and discover an issue faced by their respective communities;
 - c. Allow the young people to respond to what they have discovered and its impact to the community through service projects that address the challenges:
 - d. Answer the queries and concerns about SWA completion and its implementation;
 - e. Start-up the journey of young people towards attaining the Scouts of the World Award.

Qualifications:

- a. Must be registered with the BSP;
- b. At least Outdoorsman Rank Holder:
- c. Must be physically fit with Parent's consent.
- 4. Registration: A Registration fee of Four Hundred Pesos Only (Php. 400.00) shall be charged for each participant to defray the cost of meals and snacks, supply materials, and other related administrative and program expenses. Registration fee, transportation, incidental and other miscellaneous expenses may be charged against local funds/MOOE, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Adult leaders and Scouts will be responsible for their food for the duration of the SWA, sleeping paraphernalia, and other personal things.

- 2. Participants are required to be present at the venue at 9 AM on August 24, (Saturday) 2024.
- 5. Transportation and other incidental expenses may be charged against local funds/MOOE, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Adult Leaders registered in this scouting event will be granted service credits for services rendered on Holiday, Saturday, and Sunday subject to the existing rules and guidelines.
- 7. Full support, cooperation, and immediate dissemination of this memorandum are desired.
