YES Challenge Ja!: Inter-School Science Quiz Bowl
Guidelines and Mechanics

Objectives:

The YES Inter-school Science Quiz Bowl will be conducted on August 22, 2024 (2:00 PM - 5:00PM) at the Paghi-UsA Hall, University of Antique This activity shall be in consonance with the following objectives:

- 1 To promote excellence in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) among the youth;
- 2 To promote the role of STEM in everyday life and in our future;
- 3 To serve as a venue for discovering students with potential in STEM.

Participation:

- 1. The science quiz bowl is open to all bonafide senior high school students in the province of Antique.
- Each school must have one (1) participating team composed of two (2) student participants who are enrolled students of the high school.
- 3. The two participants for each senior high school will work as a team.
- 4. All participating teams must fill-out and pass the participant's application form on or before August 15, 2024.

Mechanics:

- 1. The contest is composed of three (3) rounds.
 - i. The first round is the Easy Round and shall be composed of fifteen (15) questions.
 - ii. The second round of guestions shall be the Average Round with ten (10) guestions.
 - iii. The third round shall be the Difficult Round composed of five (5) questions.
- 2. Participants shall be given fifteen (15) seconds to answer each question of the easy round, thirty (30) seconds for average round, and sixty (60) seconds for the difficult round questions.
- The quizmaster shall read each question twice and the participants shall wait for the go signal from the moderator before answering the question.
- Time starts as soon as the go signal has been given and ends at the sound of the buzzer in which the participants shall raise their answer.
- 5. There shall be only one (1) official timer who shall signal the end time.
- 6. The judges shall announce the correct answer of each question.
- 7. Each team shall write their answer clearly and legibly on the board, which shall be provided with marker and eraser.
- 8. There are assigned watchers participating teams who shall make sure that the rules and regulations are strictly followed. The watcher shall verify the answer of the assigned team.
- If a watcher caught a team answering before the go signal has been given, a warning will be given to that team. If a team is caught twice, that team shall not be allowed to answer that particular question.
- 10. In the case of a tie, there shall be a Clincher Round which will be composed of three given questions. The team with the highest score will be declared as winner of the tie. If the tie is not yet broken after the three questions, additional questions will be given until a winner is declared.

Scoring:

- 1. An easy question is equivalent to one (1) point, average question to three (3) points, and the difficult question to five (5) points.
- 2. At the end of the difficult round, the scorer shall sum up the total points (Easy, Average, and Difficult Rounds) of each team and determine the 2nd runner up, 1st runner up, and the Champion. The winners will be declared upon the approval of the panel of judges.

Protest:

- 1. Only the participants can make a complaint which should be raised before the next question is given.
- 2. The panel of judges shall act on the complaint and their decision is final.
