

Our expected participants will be students from both the Division of Roxas City and the Division of Capiz, with two categories: Elementary and High School (Junior and Senior High).


Through this activity, we aim to increase awareness among Capiznons about the importance of environmental conservation and the role they can play in protecting our natural resources, particularly in schools.

### ECOTALINO: ENVIRONMENTAL QUIZ BEE

#### **GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS**

OVINCE OF

- 1. The Capiz Environment and Natural Resources Office will conduct an Environmental Quiz Bee and it is open to all student both Private and Public Elementary and High Schools in the Province of Capiz (Division of Capiz and Division of Roxas City).
- 2. Each school must register two (2) participants as their official representative together with their teacher-coach assign. The participants will work as a team in the entire contest and only registered participants will be eligible to participate. They can register online.
- 3. Participants will shall bring one ½ lengthwise of long coupon bonds and a marker. And should be surrendered for checking upon registration.
- 4. All participants must be at the place of the contests at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time for briefing and orientation. Participants must wear their school uniform and ID on the day of the contest for official identification purposes.
- 5. In case of many participants will be registered on the said activity, there will be an elimination round prior to the preliminary round and it will be done days before the contest proper. The contest proper is on November 23, 2024, with venues to be arranged.
- 6. The participant's respective number is depending on their number in the registration form during the contest proper. They shall not be identified by name or school but by number.
- 7. The quiz bee will be divided into three (3) rounds—Preliminary Round, Semi-Final Round and the Final Round. In the Preliminary round, there will be twenty (20) questions that will be answered by every team. Only top ten (10) teams who gets the highest point will proceed to the next round. In case of tie, there will be an additional question, and the team who get the correct answer will be declared and qualified in the next round. And the scores for preliminary round is not counted for the semi-final round.
- 8. For the Semi-Final Round there will be fifteen (15) questions that will be answered by every team. Only five (5) teams who gets the highest point will proceed to the next round. In case of tie, there will be an additional question, and the team who get the correct answer will be declared and qualified in the next round. And the scores for semi-final round is not counted for the final round.
- 9. For the Final Round, there will be ten (10) questions that will be answered by every team. The team who got the highest scores will be declared as Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up. In case of a tie for the Champion/1st runner-up/2nd runner-up, a tie-breaker question will be given. The contestant who gives the correct answer will be declared as winner for the respective rank.
- 10. The quiz master will read the questions twice and the chalk must be raised before reading the questions. Participants must wait for the signal "GO" from the quiz master before the

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participants write their answer. And after the time allotted, the bell will ring, signifying that the participants will no longer allowed to write.

- 11. For the Preliminary and Semi-Final Round will be multiple choice, participants will be given a maximum of ten (10) seconds to answer and for the Final will be identification and it will be given fifteen (15) seconds to furnish their answers.
- 12. The topic of the said activity focuses on the following topic:
  - > Environmental Issues (including global warming and climate change; water pollution and loss of biodiversity
  - > Environmental laws and ordinances
  - >General Information and Current Issues and other aspect related on Environment
  - >Capiz and Philippine Biodiversity
- 13. Cheating and Coaching is prohibited during the contest proper. Cell phones, review materials and other reference materials is not allowed in the participant's area. Once the contest has been started, no participants will be allowed to go out on the designated area. Failure to follow will lead for disqualification.
- 14. All participants will receive Certificate of Participation and to the winners the prizes are as follows:

Champion: Php 4,000.00

1st Runner-up: Php 3,000.00 2nd Runner-up: Php 2,000.00 Consolation Prizes: Php 1,000.00

15. The decision of the Quiz master, panel and working committee of the said activity is final and irrevocable.
