Background:

Wordcraft Management Iloilo is an event-organizing group which offers training and seminar-workshops. One of the prized projects of wordcraft is a regional competition and seminar- workshop on Writing entitled, WORDCRAFT.

On its first year, Wordcraft 2016 aspired to develop the basic skills in creative expression of the participants and to instill in them the significance of writing and literature to their lives especially in the advancement of social media in accordance with the theme, "Inspiring the Next Generation of Creative Writers".

On its second year in Iloilo was another break- through regional competition with seminar-workshop entitled, WORDCRAFT 2 in 1: In Search of Journalism and Creative Writing Champions last July 22-23, 2017 at the Sarabia Manor Hotel, Iloilo City. On its third year, Wordcraft 2018 was a success through a regional Competition with seminar-workshops entitled, WORDCRAFT "Writing with impact for Gen Z" On its fourth year, Wordcraft 2019 was again a success with its theme "Molding the Write Skills with the Right Heart." The event focused on nurturing both the technical and emotional aspects of writing, encouraging participants to develop their craft with passion and authenticity.

Now, on its fifth year, Wordcraft management will hold another regional competition with seminar-workshops entitled, "WORDCRAFT: Write, Create, Inspire"
Well-known and acclaimed members of the academe, media and the literary community were chosen to speak and discuss in their respective field of expertise to further enhance the knowledge and skills of the participants. The abovementioned event will also include an Art Competition advocating sustainability through art. It also intends to encourage the advocacy of preserving the art of writing and the value of local and national literature.

Day 1 – Creative Writing: Flash Fiction, Poetry Writing, Vlogging, Spoken Word Poetry, Day 2 – Journalism: News Writing, Editorial Writing, Feature Writing, Cartooning, Art Making

The lectures will be followed with one-hour writing competitions for the following age levels: Grade 3, Grades 4 to 6, and junior high school. The winners will be announced during the socials night and on the last days of the event.

Objectives

This competition and seminar-workshop intends to:

- Develop the knowledge and skills of the participants both in journalism and creative expression through comprehensive lectures, discussions, and workshops;
- Enhance the potentials of young writers especially in the various forms of journalism, creative writing and social media; and
- Encourage the participants' love for literature and creative writing and inspire responsible journalism.
- Introduce the concept of sustainability through art.
