

SUBJECT: CAPIZ COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM 2025

- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Capiz Council will conduct the YOUTH FORUM on February 28. - March 2, 2025, at President Manuel A. Roxas Memorial Integrated School-South, Tanque, Roxas City, with theme: "Sustaining Growth"
- 2 The Scout Youth Forum is a primordial part of the Youth Development Program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines. It is organized to fill in the need and the clamor for youth participation in the decision-making process in the Scout Movement. It is a place for information, training and concrete experience of discussing and acquiring a deeper understanding of various issues. It is also a source of inspiration by providing contact with new people, fresh ideas, innovative thoughts, different experiences and working methods.
- 3 The Scout Youth Forum aims to provide a dual opportunity for young people to discuss and express their views on issues of interest to them, and help develop the skills necessary to strengthen their capacity to take part in decision-making process and to actively be involved in their own communities, institutions.

4 Qualification

- a. Must be currently registered Senior Scouts
- b. Must be 14-18 years of age upon the time of election Senior Scouts who are 19 years of age upon the election shall not be allowed to participate due to technicalities over the age mid-term.
- c. Must have been elected in prior levels of the Scout Youth Forum.
- d. Must be a holder of at least Outdoorsman Rank in the Advancement Scheme.
- e Each Institution is entitled of three (3) voting delegates and a maximum of five (5) observers
- 5. Registration Fee. A registration fee of Two Hundred Pesos (Php 200.00) shall be charged to each participant to defray the cost of administrative and program expenses. Registration fees, transportation, incidental and other miscellaneous expenses may be charge against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
- 6. All participants are advised to wear their Type A or B Scout Uniform.

- 7. Adult leaders and Scouts will be responsible for their food for the duration of the forum
- 8. Things to Bring:
 - a Duly Signed Parental Consent
 - b. Type A Uniform
 - Sleeping Gear, Maintenance Medicine, Toiletnes, Enough Clothes for the duration of the event
 - d. 1 Set Smart Casual
- 9 it is desired that each institution should conduct a School Scout Youth Forum to be familiar with forum procedures.
- 10. Participants are advised to be at the venue at 5:00 PM on February 28, 2025.
- 11 Adult Leaders registered as support staff, and chaperones in this scouting event will be granted service credit for services rendered on Saturday and Sunday, subject to existing rules and guidelines as DECS order Memorandum 142. Series of 1997.
