

SUBJECT: CREW LEADER TRAINING COURSE

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Capiz Council will conduct the CREW LEADER TRAINING COURSE with the theme "Service, Innovation, and25 Scouting for all".

The purpose of this activity is to train Scout Leaders in their responsibilities in the Crew and to equip them with the necessary scouting skills that they could share with their members in the Outfit/Institution and the community.

2. The training fee is Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 250.00) charged per scout to help defray expenses for the food and transportation of the staff, training materials, certificates, and host share for light, water and sound. Hereunder are the details for your information:

- 3. Scouts/Scout Leaders/Teachers participants must be currently registered with BSP, physically fit and with a parent's permit (Scout). Type A or Type B Uniform will be the attire during the activity. Scouts and Scout Leaders will be responsible for their own food for the duration of the training, sleeping paraphernalia and other personal things.
- 4. Each Institution can send a delegation of a minimum of 8 Scouts and a Maximum of 32 Scouts.
- 5. Scouter Leaders registered as chaperon in this scouting event will be granted service credits for services rendered on Saturday and Sunday, subject to existing rules and guidelines.

6. Kindly inform the BSP, Capiz Council, of the number of participants one week before the schedule.
