IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS: BASIC ACCOUNTING QUIZ BOWL COMPETITION YEAR 3



BASIC ACCOUNTING QUIZ BOWL: An Invitational Quiz Bee Competition

IRR 1 BACKGROUND

- Section 1: In line with the celebration of the 78th Foundation Day of Colegio de la Purisima Concepcion, the Colegio de la Purisima Concepcion — Junior Philippine Institute of Accountants organized a quiz bowl for ABM students coming from different schools within the province of Capiz to compete and win the corresponding prizes. This event will promote academic excellence and camaraderie. Basic accounting quiz bowl aims to develop, expound, and sharpen the understanding and critical thinking skills of the students regarding accounting concepts and problems. CPC-JPIA further believes that through this activity, the students will also be able to develop academic excellence and camaraderie among their fellow ABM students.

IRR 2 REQUIREMENTS

- Section 1: There must **be one (1) team per school**, composed of **three (3) individuals**. Two (2) participants must come from **Grade 12** and one (1) participant from **Grade 11**. All three individuals must be taken from **ABM Strand**.
- Section 2: Schools must submit their lineup in PDF form through the organization's email: **cpcjpia.nfj pia2526@gmail.com** or to the email of the president of JPIA, Angel Grace D. Palete: **cpcpresident.nfj pia2526@gmail.com** with the corresponding format attached in this IRR. The submission may be in scanned PDF form or they can access the downloadable format through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/CPC-JPIA>. The schools may also submit their lineup personally at CPC Main Campus – College of Business, Management and Accountancy Dean's Office.
- Section 3: The deadline of submission of the lineup is on **February 18, 2025**.
- Section 4: **School uniforms and IDs** must be worn during the day of event.

IRR 3 SCHEDULES AND LOCATION

- Section 1: The event will be on **February 20, 2025**. The event will start at **1:00 PM until 4:00PM**.
- Section 2: The event will be held at CPC Main Campus, Third Floor - Rooms 311 and 312.
- Section 3: Participants must register 30 minutes prior the starting time of the event.

IRR 4 EVENT MECHANICS

- Section 1: The coverage of the quiz bowl is **Fundamentals of ABM 1 and 2**.
- Section 2: The call time and registration for the competition will start at 12:00 PM and will end at 1:00 PM. All participants must be present in the given location where the quiz bowl will take place.
- Section 3: Latecomers will be disqualified when the event has begun.
- Section 4: The CPC JPIA Council will provide materials that shall be used in the event (flashcards, and clean sheets of paper for solving).
- Section 5: The participants must bring their own **basic calculators**. Scientific, financial, or programmable calculators shall not be allowed in the competition. Only **one (1)** basic calculator per team will be allowed during competition.
- Section 6: Board of Arbiter/s for the event shall be selected by the Local Chapter Executive Officers and shall have the appropriate credentials to judge a particular event.
- Section 7: Any form of cheating shall not be tolerated. Participants who will be caught cheating will automatically be disqualified from the competition and shall be banned from CPC JPIA's upcoming events.
- Section 8: All of the questions shall be in multiple choice type with four (4) choices for each question.
- Section 9: Each team will be given four (4) flashcards; containing A, B, C and D, and the team will decide who will raise their answers when the host says so.
- Section 10: Questions will be given to the teams by the assigned facilitator and will be read by the quizmaster once.
- Section 11: The participants are **allowed** only to manipulate their basic calculators when the quizmaster says **"GO"**. Any participant who violates these stipulations shall be given



a **warning** for the 1st offense. On the **2nd offense**, the contestant shall be given a sanction of accumulating only **50%** of his/her/their total score garnered in all rounds. On the **3rd offense**, the participant shall be **disqualified** from the category.

- Section 12: The participants should have chosen their answer before the “**STOP**” signal which means that the time allotted for that question has ended. The participants must raise the flashcards after the host announces so, and any group that fails will receive a warning and the answer of the group may be forfeited depending upon the decision of the Academics Committee.
- Section 13: After the host signals to raise the flashcards, all teams must stay raising until the host announces the correct answer, the host will announce the team who answered correctly, and the tabulation committee records the points obtained by each participant for the correct answer.
- Section 14: Before continuing to the next question, an allotted time of **ten (10) seconds** will be given for the participants to inquire whether they have queries or clarifications regarding the solution of the question, request for scratch paper, changing of basic calculators, or other concerns related. If the time allotted for queries is done, no protest or any concerns shall be entertained.
- Section 15: Failure to answer in the specific time allocated will not receive any points. After each round, the tabulation team will display and read the scores of each team in that category.
- Section 16: The Accounting Quiz bowl shall comprise three rounds, namely: Easy, Average, and Difficult Category. Time allotment, number of items, and corresponding points are as follows:

	Easy	Average	Difficult	Clincher

- Section 17: In case of a tie, after the difficult round, clincher questions shall be given to the participants until the deadlock is broken. This will be called the Clincher Round. The question shall be read twice by the quizmaster, as an exception to the general rule. Tiebreaker questions shall have NO bearing on the cumulative score of the contestants.
- Section 18: Participants will be given **three (3) minutes** after each round to raise a question, a protest, or a clarification about the preceding round. Protests/clarifications/concerns will only be acknowledged if the participant raises their hand during the allotted time. The participants are the only ones who have vested rights to raise concerns, protest, and/or clarification.

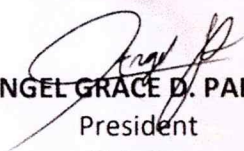
