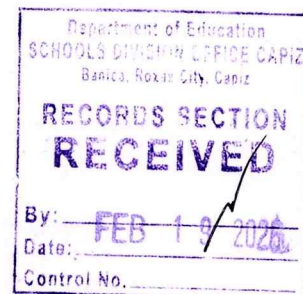

SUBJECT: BADEN-POWELL DAY 2026

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Capiz Council, will hold the Baden-Powell Day 2026 Celebration in a fitting series of activities in the Home, School, and Community, with the theme "Sustaining Growth."
2. **Historical Background.** On 22 February every year, millions of Scouts around the world gather at local, national and international levels to celebrate the Founder's Day, the birthday of Lord Robert Stephenson Smyth Baden Powell (1857-1941)/ the pioneer of Scouting. Among the Boys Scouts and Girl Guides, this special day is called the "Founder's Day || World Thinking Day" celebration, reaffirming their commitment to the Movement's core values.
3. **Aim and Objectives:** The Founders' Day is celebrated to create awareness and online crowdsourcing to and from Scouting communities in various parts of the country. It encourages everyone to reflect on his vision and empowers our promise to further unite our young people in peace, as we develop a challenging nation and create a better world.

This can be achieved through the following:

- a. Work in partnership with young people to initiate a community service project that will benefit a certain community in line with peace, development and the environment;
- b. Organize a celebration and/or gathering reaffirming and re-dedicating ourselves to the Ideals and the Fundamentals Principle of Scouting and the Scout Oath and Law;
- c. Engage and involve more young in the community and be able to create a social impact through various Scouting Activities and programs that Scouting is an educational movement of young people;
- d. Suggested activities:
 - Weekend Backyard Camp
 - Green is Go! Go for the real thing project (Tree Planting/Mangrove Planting)
 - Outreach Program

- Coastal Clean-up
- Institutional Board of Review

4. **Period of Action.** As we join this world celebration, Scouts and Leaders in all Districts/Schools are encouraged to hold service projects related to peace, development and environmental initiatives from February 17,21,22,25,28 2026, at their home, school, neighborhood and community.
5. Adult Leaders who serve in this scouting event will be granted service credit for services rendered on Saturday and Sunday, subject to existing rules and guidelines as DECS order Memorandum 142 Series of 1997 and enclosed to DO No. 13, 2024-Section V A.1.b, 8. c.) DepEd Order No. 13, 2024.
