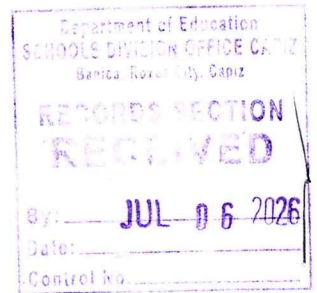

The Hong Kong Girl Guides Association (HKGGA) is celebrating its historic 110th Anniversary by hosting an international camp that brings together Girl Guides and Girl Scouts from all over the world. This event offers an incredible opportunity for our Cadet Girl Scouts and adult leaders to experience international friendship, digital innovation, and leadership development in a global setting.

1. Event Details

- **Title:** *Lead Her Pixoverse* – HKGGA 110th Anniversary International Camp
- **Date:** 23-27 December 2026
- **Venue:** Runway 1331, Hong Kong
- **Host:** Hong Kong Girl Guides Association

2. Objectives

- To celebrate 110 years of guiding in Hong Kong.
- To foster international friendship and cultural exchange.
- To provide opportunities for leadership development and innovative learning experiences.
- To strengthen the global guiding movement through collaboration and shared activities.

3. Eligibility and Patrol Structure

Participants : 8 Registered Cadet Girl Scouts aged 18-21

Adult Leader : 1 Leader-In-Charge (aged 26 and above)
1 Young Leader (aged 22-25)

Patrol Requirement : Each GSP Region is invited to send 1 patrol consisting of 2 Troop/Young Adult Leader and 8 Cadet Girl Scouts, preferably from different Councils

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4. Registration Fees and Financial Logistics

- Camp Fee: USD 350.00 (approx. ₱21,451.50) per participant
- Inclusions:
 - ✓ Camp accommodation
 - ✓ All meals during the event
 - ✓ Camp kit/souvenirs
 - ✓ Local transportation to and from designated points
 - ✓ All official program activities
- Exclusions:
 - ✓ Roundtrip airfare to Hong Kong
 - ✓ Travel Insurance
 - ✓ Visa Processing (if applicable)
 - ✓ Personal pocket money
- Additional Notes:
 - ✓ The International Affairs Division will assist in booking tickets and purchasing of travel insurance
 - ✓ **No visa required** for Philippine passport holders for stay up to 14 days

Important Notes on Registration Fee Payment:

- The registration fee payment is subject to the prevailing exchange rate on the day of the telegraphic transfer.
- Any bank charges incurred during the transfer, as well as any exchange rate differences, must be shouldered by the participant.
- Payment in USD is preferred and will be appreciated.
- In case the participant fails to transfer the payment by the deadline date, she will not be included in the telegraphic transfer process.
- The GSP Finance Division will only conduct a one-time transfer; no additional transfers will be processed.

Other expenses to be incurred when participating in an international event (aside from the Registration Fee) include:

- a. Roundtrip Airline Fare and Philippine Travel Tax
- b. Travel Insurance
- c. Pre- and Post-stay at the GSP NHQ Dormitory (5th Floor or Annex Building)
- d. Pre-Departure Orientation (PDO)

All fees must be settled with the GSP Finance Division before departure. The timeline is as follows:

Registration Fee	1 week before the telegraphic transfer
Roundtrip Airline Fare and Philippine Travel Tax	after payment of the Registration Fee
Travel Insurance and Pre-Departure orientation	15 days before the scheduled PDO
Pre- and Post Stay at GSP NHQ Dormitory (5 th Floor or Annex Building)	paid directly at the GSP Finance Division

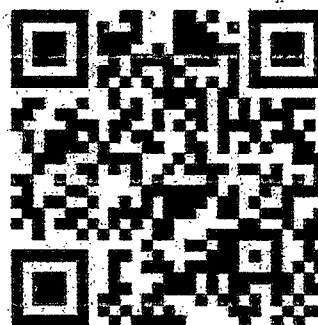

National Outstanding Awardees will receive **free accommodation** at the GSP NHQ 5th floor fan room during their **pre- and post-stay**. Additionally, the **Pre-Departure Orientation** will also be provided at no cost.

However, the **registration fee, roundtrip airline fare and Philippine travel tax, and travel insurance** will be deducted from their grant. Any additional expenses beyond the allocated international travel grant must be covered by the participant.

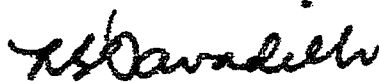
