- 1. In line with the MATATAG agenda and the National Learning Recovery Program (NLRP), this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct a **Division Training-Workshop on Technology Enhanced Learning Approaches in Science for Schools Implementing Special Science Elementary Schools (SSES)** on December 19, 20 and 21, 2023 at a venue to be announced later.
- 2. This training-workshop aims to provide participants the necessary information and experience regarding technology enhanced learning (TEL) approaches in Science. The exposure may transform into innovative interactive design and conduct of TEL lesson in their own classroom. The course will primarily involve interactive minds-on and hands-on activities that emphasize a good learning theory with reflective classroom practices based on TEL. The knowledge and skills acquired would enable participants to initiate TEL lessons for improving science classroom practices in their respective schools.
- 3.
