In line with the successful launch of the first child protection e-learning course for educators conducted last year, with six thousand eight hundred eighty-six (6,886) course completers, six thousand six hundred six (6,606) of which are licensed teachers.

This Office, through the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) in partnership with the Stairway Foundation, Inc., (SFI) will launch the second batch of the Child Protection eLearning Course, which is fully asynchronous and is designed for educators to develop a deeper understanding of the ever-evolving child protection concerns, online and offline. The Course aims to empower educators with tools and education materials that may be used for advocating learning rights.

The eLearning Course is accredited by the Professional Regulations Commission and is open for teaching and non-teaching personnel, it is free of charge, and licensed teachers who have completed the course will gain a corresponding ten (10) Continuing Professional Development (CPD) points.

Relatedly, with the clamor of different regions for additional slots, the course will be opened to ten thousand (10,000) participants nationwide. Enclosed is a copy of the instruction briefer which may also be accessed at this link:

Child Protection E-learning Course for Educators

What is the course about?

The course is specifically designed for educators in order for them to develop a deeper understanding of the various child protection concerns that their learners might face both offline and online. Crafted by the DepEd Learner Rights and Protection Office and Stairway Foundation, the course aims to empower educators to have the knowledge and tools to participate more in the protection of the learners they work with. The course is offered free for DepEd Personnel, with corresponding 10 CPD points for Licensed Professional Teachers

How is the course delivered?

The course is **fully asynchronous and self-paced** and thus, you can take the lessons at any time depending in your availability. The course contains short videos lessons, interactive content and resource links.

Objectives of the Course

At the end of the course, participants are expected to;

- 1. Identify the various offline and online child protection concerns that learners might encounter.
- 2. Identify the various means these child protection concerns might be perpetrated.
- 3. Get to know the various key messages that can be integrated for child protection education.
- Distinguish what DepEd policy and protocol should be applied for specific child protection concerns.
- 5. Be introduced to the various initiatives of DepEd in relation to child protection






Self Enrollment Guidelines

There are 2 steps before one can fully participate in the course. The first one is the creation of a "User Account" in the e-learning platform. Here you will register as a user in our Learning Management System, and create your own profile. Make sure that your carefully input your name in your profile, as this will also be the same text that our Learning Management System will use in your certificate of completion. Please follow the steps below;

User Account Creation. There are 2 options in creating your user account.

Account Creation Option 1: Recommended (For those with Gmail accounts)

- a. Please follow this link https://elearning.stairwayfoundation.org/login/mdex.php
- Ensuring that you have a working and accessible Gmail account, click on the "Log in using your account on:" Click Google



- c. You will be redirected to the Google account page; choose the Google account you want your e-learning account to be associated with
- d. Every time you will login to the e-learning platform, just repeat this option, which you can access again via the home page by clicking on "Moodle Login Page"







Account Creation Option 2: (for Gmail and non-Gmail account holders)

Follow these steps if option 1 doesn't work for you. If option 1 works, then you do not need to follow these steps, you may proceed directly to the course enrollment step.

- a. Login to your Stairway eLearning account, or if you do not have one yet, create an account on this platform via this link https://bit.lv/StairwayELearningSignUp
- b. In creating a user account, please ensure that you shall use a valid and accessible email address, double checking for any spelling errors.
- After successfully entering all the required details, an account creation email shall be sent your email. Please click on this to confirm activation.
 If the account confirmation email can't be found in your inbox, please check your spam folder

After creating your user account in the Stairway e-learning platform, the next step is to enroll yourself in the actual course itself. Please follow the steps below.

- 2. Course Enrollment: After successfully creating your e-learning account, please follow the instructions below to enroll in the course.
 - a. After logging in or creating your user account (making sure you are logged in), come back to this course:

 - b. Enter the enrollment key LRPOCHILDPRO via the self-enrollment section which can be found at the bottom of the self-enrollment page.
 - c. You are now enrolled! The course will be available in your e-learning dashboard
 - d. Course enrollment is from May 13 to June 30, 2024
 - e. Course duration shall be from May 13 to June 30, 2024





important reminders;

- Participants are expected to finish the final course activity "course completer's survey", on or before the course duration date end (June 30, 2024)
- This final course activity will automatically close on June 30, 2024. There will be no more course duration extensions.
- Make sure that the entries you enter in the course completion survey, are your own information
 and are correct based on what is reflected in your PRC License. The course completion survey
 is what we shall submit to the PRC as the official list of completers.
- We shall not be able to entertain requests for edits of the course completion survey, so we
 encourage participants to practice due diligence in completing and supplying the correct details
 in the course completion survey.
- Incomplete/Incorrect PRC details as supplied by the participants in the course completion survey will not be credited by the PRC. We reiterate that this is the responsibility of participants.
- For successful course completers whose CPD points were not credited in their CPDAS,
 Stairway shall bear no responsibility for the CPDAS not accepting a participant's license details because of wrong entry in the course completion survey.
- Participants are prohibited from allowing other individuals to use their e-learning account for whatever purpose. Doing so will be a violation of the terms of usage for this course.
- By continuing to the course, you hereby signify that you acknowledge and agree to these reminders and conditions.

Basic Troubleshooting guide

If you encounter any technical concerns regarding the course navigation, please follow these basic trouble shooting guide;

- Ensure that you have a stable Internet connection. Sometimes, even with high internet speeds, your "ping" or "latency" might be not optimal (Internet connection quality).
- Try accessing the course via another device. The course is primarily designed for laptop/desktop access.
- You might have missed a certain task within an interactive lesson, this might be the reason you
 can't proceed yet. Make sure all tasks are completed.
- Try to refresh your browser.
- Try to log-out, then log-in again from your e-learning account. The system will remember where
 you left off.
