- We take notice that DepEd Operating Units (OUs) are submitting special budget 1.0 requests (SBR) to this Office for the release of additional cash allocation to cover operating requirements and for payment of other due and demandable obligations.
- Evaluation of these requests revealed that some SBRs are of a minimal amount 2.0 which may be charged against its available released cash allocation consistent with the principle of Common Fund System (CFS).

A sample tabular presentation is provided below as reference:

- 3.0 Under the CFS, cash allocation released under the Regular MDS Sub-Account of agencies can be used to cover payment of both current year and prior years' Accounts Payable (AP) due to all creditors (external and internal).
 - It is understood however that payment of mandatories, i.e., PS, MOOE and CO requirements, shall take precedence over APs in the utilization of NCAs received. Only when the mandatory requirements are satisfied can the payment of APs be charged against the available cash allocation, as provided under Item 4.2.1.6 of National Budget Circular (NBC) No. 592² dated 02 January 2024.
- 4.0 Furthermore, this fiscal measure would be beneficial to minimize the bulk of lapsed cash allocation due to non-utilization of agencies.
- 5.0 To maximize the disbursements of funds, **DepEd OUs shall strictly observe** the CFS and utilize its available cash allocation to cover the funding requirements of sub-allotment release orders and other obligational authorities, if possible.
- 6.0 In instances where a DepEd OU has insufficient cash allocation, an SBR may be submitted to this Office duly supported with a **strong justification** stated therein.
- 7.0 SDOs are enjoined to validate all budgetary requests of SS-IUs under its functional jurisdiction, as to the propriety of the amount being requested and the justification provided, including the completeness and orderliness of the documentary requirements. In this way, frequent returning of requests with just a minimal observation can be avoided as well as fast track the issuance of the necessary action documents.
- 8.0 Lastly, DepEd OUs shall ensure timely, complete, and accurate submission of reportorial requirements pursuant to Commission on Audit (COA)-DBM Joint Circular (JC) 2019-1³ dated 1 January 2019, and as reiterated under DBM Circular Letter (CL) No. 2024-5⁴ dated 27 February 2024, with due prudence, consistency, and accuracy on the information provided for an effective monitoring of cash disbursements and balances which are vital in the course of evaluation of requests for release of additional cash allocation.
- 9.0 For guidance and strict compliance. Thank you.
