

The Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) is a human development program of the national government that invests in the health and education of poor households particularly of children aged 0-18 years old. As the flagship poverty reduction strategy of the Philippines, this program is being implemented in partnership with Local Government Units, National Government Agencies, Civil Society Organizations, and Private Sectors as key stakeholders.

The Supply-side Assessment (SSA) is conducted in all 4Ps areas to determine the gaps in both health and education facilities that necessitate action from the key partner agencies and to ensure that facilities are available in order for the beneficiaries to comply with the set program conditions.

Anent this, we would like to request your good office to share your Supply-side Assessment (SSA) result to be consolidated and be presented to the City/Municipal, Provincial and Regional Convergence Committee before the end of the year.

PURPOSE OF THE DATA SHARING

The data will be shared for the following purpose of 1.) assessing the present condition of health and education systems at the city/municipality and barangays levels; 2.) define the gaps and needs, if any, and their corresponding solutions and recommendations to enable the Pantawid Pamilya beneficiaries to meet the conditions of the program; 3.) and secure the commitment of LGUs and key partner agencies on supply – side concerns.


