- 1. In adherence to DepEd Order No. 029, s. 2022 titled Adoption of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework and Regional Memorandum No. 1032, s. 2024 titled Program Implementation Review and Performance Assessment (PIRPA), this Office announces the transition from School Monitoring, Evaluation, and Adjustment to School Program Implementation Review and Performance Assessment (PIRPA) starting the 4th Quarter of 2024.
- 2. The PIRPA is established as the department's reporting platform of the operating units at all governance levels. It is conducted quarterly to report the accomplishments of outputs in terms of efficiency and corresponding budget utilization.
- 3. In this regard, all elementary, secondary and integrated school heads are directed to conduct their **Fourth Quarter School PIRPA** activities on the following schedule:

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- 4. This activity aims to present the:
 - a. status of performance indicators and accomplishments for the quarter;
 - b. completed outputs based on the Work and Financial Plan;
 - c. status of the major programs;
 - d. overall assessment of Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs); and
 - e. issues/concerns and for the reasons the underachievement/overachievement of PPA implementation captured through the Bottlenecks, Lags, Issues, and Concerns (BLICs).
- 5. All schools shall conduct a school PIRPA to examine the progress of the plans in terms of physical implementation, schedule, and financial performance based on the committed outputs in the approved Work and Financial Plan. This will review whether the targeted outputs were delivered as scheduled and whether the proposed funding was executed as planned. The conduct of the school PIRPA and validation of accomplishments shall be monitored and participated in by the Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisors, and other division office personnel.
- 6. The process for conducting the school PIRPA will still be based on Regional Memorandum No. 167, s. 2023, titled 'Guidelines on the Conduct of Regional/Division/School Monitoring, Evaluation, and Adjustment.
- 7. Attached are the Key Performance Indicators to be gathered for the fourth quarter of 2024 (October to December 2024), validation checklist, Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) tool and the templates to be used for your guidance. Cut-off date for the data to be collected is December 11, 2024.
- 8. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the above activity shall be charged against the School MOOE Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
