- 1. This Office, through the School Management, Monitoring, and Evaluation (SMME) Unit of the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), will conduct the 2024 National Learning Camp Assessment (NLCA) Program Implementation Review on December 7, 2024 at the Capiz Division Multipurpose Hall, Banica, Roxas City.
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - a. review the administration of the National Learning Camp Assessment; and

On the other hand, Non-Teaching personnel including the management staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) as per civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on *Non-Monetary Renumeration for Overtime Service Rendered*.
