### SELECTION GUIDELINES FOR INCOMING LEARNERS IN SPECIAL SCIENCE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS (SSES) AND SCIENCE. TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING (STE) PROGRAMS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), issues the Regional Selection Guidelines for Incoming Learners of Grade 1 SSES and Grade 7 STE for SY 2025-2026.
- 2. In preparation for the incoming school year, the Qualifying Admission Tests (QAT) shall be administered to applicants who meet the following basic requirements, to wit:

STE	Must be a Grade 6 Graduate  Learner must obtain an average rating of at least 85% in Grade 6 English, Science, and Mathematics (From First to Third Quarters)	<ol> <li>Duly Accomplished Application Form with 1X1 ID Picture</li> <li>Certified Photocopy of SF 9 (School Report Card)</li> <li>Certified Photocopy of PSA Birth Certificate</li> <li>Certificate of Good Moral Character</li> <li>Medical Certificate</li> </ol>

The selection for Grade 1 SSES and Grade 7 STE learners shall be done in the following phases to determine the final qualifiers:
