Dear Mr. Bermejo,

Greetings of good health!

In light of the increasing dengue cases in other provinces and in consonance with the Department of Health memorandum on the prevention and control of dengue, all provinces and cities are enjoined to participate in the nationwide search and destroy of mosquito breeding sites every 4:00 in the afternoon in all government institutions nationwide.

As our active partner in health, we would like to request the implementation of the 4'oclock habit in all schools and offices. This event will strengthen our collective efforts in controlling the spread of dengue by identifying and eliminating mosquito breeding sites in order to have a safe and healthy workplace. The following measures will be implemented during the 4o'clock habit:

- Clean indoor spaces daily and collect items that are likely to collect water and dispose properly.
- Replace and clean water collecting containers every 2 days and cover properly to avoid breeding of mosquitoes.
- Search and destroy breeding sites in school premises. These are water collecting garbage
 like bottles, plastic containers, caps, coconut shells, bamboo poles as well as plants that
 collect water like bromeliads, gabi stalks among others.
- Monitor pupils for incidence of fever and separate them for monitoring. Check installed treated screens for holes and cover this in order to avoid further spread of dengue.
- Avoid giving aspirin for headache and use only paracetamol.

Let us keep our workplaces and every household safe from dengue.
