Greetings of Good Health!

The Provincial Health Office would like to inform you of a pressing health concern that may affect the communities during the upcoming Brigada Eskwela Program, scheduled for June 9-13, 2025. As of Morbidity Week 20, the Department of Health (DOH) has reported a significant increase in dengue cases across the region with 4,741 recorded cases and an 86% increase as compared to the same period of FY 2024.

Based on the report, school-aged children and adolescents are mostly among the affected age group underscoring the need for immediate and targeted health interventions in schools and educational settings. In the province, **Panay** and **Tapaz** with Brgy. Pob. Ilaya and Brgy, Poblacion has been reported respectively as an area with clustering of cases.

With this, we highly encourage that **Search and Destroy** efforts will be conducted in the school premises in order to eliminate potential mosquito breeding grounds with continuous vector surveillance.

These measures are critical to prevent further spread and protect the health of our students, teachers, and the community. We humbly ask for your cooperation in ensuring that these precautions are carried out effectively to safeguard public health and safety during this crucial time.
