This comprehensive training serves as a crucial component of our strengthened efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of every learner. It is also a timely and necessary response to recent directives from the Department of Education (DepEd). Under the leadership of Education Secretary Sonny Angara, a more comprehensive and stringent Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) for the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013 has been released. This workshop is vital for our Public Schools District Supervisors, School Heads, Designated Guidance Counselors and Learner Rights and Protection Focal Persons to fully understand the new IRR and its implications for our schools, ensuring SDO Capiz is fully compliant with national standards.

By focusing on the creation of a Localized Anti-Bullying Policy, we will be able to move beyond a generic approach and tailor the national guidelines to the specific needs and cultural context of our communities. This localization is a critical step to ensure the policy is not just a document on a shelf, but a practical and effective tool that works for our students. Furthermore, the workshop's core mandate is the integration of DepEd's Mental Health and Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) standards directly into the policy framework, establishing a holistic approach to student protection and support.

The workshop will also guide the development of a Learner's Code of Conduct, which complements the anti-bullying policy by promoting a culture of respect, accountability, and discipline. This code will serve as a foundational guide for student behavior, empowering our schools to proactively address issues and foster a positive atmosphere for both academic and personal growth.

In essence, this training is a strategic and timely initiative to align our division's practices with the new national standards while directly addressing the rising local challenges. It is a proactive measure to ensure that every learner in SDO Capiz is safeguarded and equipped to succeed in a secure and nurturing educational environment.

11. **OBJECTIVES:**

At the end of the training workshop, the participants will be able to:

- 1. Analyze and apply the key provisions and new Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013 (DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2024), ensuring SDO Capiz's full compliance with national standards.
- 2. Formulate a culturally sensitive and localized Anti-Bullying Policy that effectively addresses the specific types of bullying prevalent in SDO Capiz schools, seamlessly integrating provisions for Mental Health and Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) support services.
- 3. Develop a comprehensive and context-responsive Learner's Code of Conduct that complements the anti-bullying policy by promoting a culture of respect, accountability, and positive behavior.
- 4. Design a Localized Division Anti-Bullying Referral and Intervention Protocol that clearly outlines reporting, investigation, and disciplinary procedures, while also incorporating pathways for mental health first-aid and referral.
